

This is said to be the best treatment for a dog who's had a close encounter with a skunk. Reportedly, it won't affect the coat color.



1 QT	Hydrogen peroxide (3%)
1/4 CUP	Baking soda
1 TSP	Dishwashing liquid (such as Dawn)

Mix the soda and soap together and then add the peroxide.

Soak your dog in this solution for a while and then rinse it off. You'll probably have to repeat this process several times.

NOTE: You have to mix the solution just before using it and discard it after use — you *cannot* store it! (The mixture is volatile.)

You can also use Massengil douche (especially as a rinse) because the main ingredient is white vinegar. Tomato juice is the traditional treatment but probably any citric juice would work as well.
